As you embark on this new chapter, you may come with varying levels of experience with computing. Regardless of your background, we know you'll be keen to explore the computing and internet facilities we offer. To assist you, our IT Department has put together a website detailing the services available both within Oriel and across the wider University. Here are two key points to help you get started:

1. Your Oxford Account

You will receive two emails from the 'Student Information & Advisory Service'. The first email will contain your Student Number, and the second will provide details about your Oxford 'Single Sign-On' (SSO) account. It is crucial to follow the instructions in this second email to activate your SSO account. This account is essential for accessing most university systems, including your email and various resources.

2. Connecting to the Internet

Oxford University uses a 'Remote Access account' for internet connectivity, which is separate from your SSO account. To ensure you're online as soon as possible, we recommend setting up your Remote Access account before you arrive. After activating your Oxford SSO account, visit <https://register.it.ox.ac.uk> to register for your Remote Access account. This will provide you with the username and password needed to connect to the College and university wireless networks.
